

THE STYLISH rooms impress, NOT ONLY WITH AN abundance of greenery, BUT ALSO WITH EXCITING DECOR, SKILFUL colour combinations AND INVITING furniture.

The Pigment restaurant in the basement serves dishes inspired by the hotel's motifs and the secret Viennese garden, while the floorto-ceiling plants all around create a cozy atmosphere both in the morning at breakfast and in the evening at dinner. Afterwards, it's time for a drink in the hotel's own bar, where locals and guests can celebrate with fine cocktails.
